John Briere, Ph.D. is Associate Professor of Psychiatry at the Keck School of Medicine, University of Southern California and Center Director of the USC Adolescent Trauma Training Center of the National Child Traumatic Stress Network. A past president of the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies (ISTSS), he is a recipient of the Robert S. Laufer Memorial Award for Scientific Achievement from ISTSS and the Award for Outstanding Contributions to the Science of Trauma Psychology from the American Psychological Association (Division 56). He has been designated as "Highly Cited Researcher" by the Institute for Scientific Information, and is author or co-author of over 100 articles and chapters, 11 books, two treatment manuals, and nine psychological tests in the areas of trauma, child abuse, and interpersonal violence.

Program Description

Dr. Briere will provide an overview of "Integrative Treatment of Complex Trauma for Adolescents". The treatment approach was developed to assist clinicians in the evaluation and treatment of adolescents who have experienced multiple forms of psychological trauma, often in the context of negative living conditions such as poverty, deprivation and social discrimination. A copy of the treatment guide will be made available to attendees to read prior to the workshop. The core components of ITCT include: Assessment driven treatment; attention to complex trauma issues; use of multiple treatment modalities; relational processing of early attachment schema and current interpersonal expectations; skills development; therapeutic exposure and exploration of trauma and advocacy and interventions at the system level. ITCT has been listed by the National Child Traumatic Stress Network as a trauma-informed intervention.

Learning Objectives

- Participants will be able to identify the major effects of complex trauma on adolescents.
- Participants will be able to list at least three different treatment components of ITCT-A.
- Participants will be able to describe the primary benefits of the therapeutic relationship in treating youths affected by trauma.
- Participants will become familiar with how to assess complex trauma in adolescents using guidelines and tools from ITCT-A.
