## Finance & Operations Committee

- 1. Should the need arise, limit withdrawal of reserve funds to 10% of total reserve this fiscal year (2022-2023)
- 2. Review all dues structure annually
- 3. Review by-laws and employee handbook annually

## Government Relations Committee

- 1. Partnership for appropriate placements
  - Placement and referral process
  - Appeals and disruptions
  - Collaborative placement calls start back?
  - Possible litigation against DCS
- 2. Foster parent recruitment and Level 2 RTC (opening beds)
  - Partnerships to increase # beds
  - Shared home policy/transfers to therapeutic
  - Is there a way to increase L2 effectively?
  - Change the stigma (FP+staff) campaign
  - SIU (Suspended admissions, past hx)
- 3. PBC
- 4. Case manager qualifications
- 5. Family first

### Membership Committee

- 1. Identify new members (\*2023 January)
  - Suggestions from board
  - Pursue PBC providers who aren't members
- 2. Follow-up with members who miss 2 meetings in a row (\*ongoing)
  - Assign follow-up with people who have relationship
- 3. Identify mentors amount Alliance members to help when starting new programs (\*October 2022)
- 4. Facebook enhancement (\*August 2022)
  - Posting schedule to highlight members
  - Featuring Alliance events
  - Assign someone to take photos/videos
  - Work with Darci and PT person to improve social media presence
    - Instagram/LinkedIn?
    - o Link to social media in e-mail signature
- 5. Revitalization of regional boards (\*ongoing)
  - Identify who is not participating
  - Define goals of regional boards
    - o Education, connection with legislators, connect with DCS in region
  - Trainings offered regionally, relevant topic one per region/year
    - Topics/speakers

### Legislative Committee

- 1. Clarify steps necessary to take a position on a piece of legislation
- 2. Refocus on attendance at Hill Day show a presence
  - Consider providing breakfast/coffee (in advance of Hill Day or same day)
- 3. Each agency to appoint a legislative liaison to attend Alliance trainings and legislative events
- 4. Idea of Alliance sponsoring an event directly prior to Hill Day (mixer/social/golf tournament/fun)
- 5. Work on having provider rate increases occur automatically whenever DCS receives budget increase
- 6. Work on assessing viability of eliminating \$ penalties
- 7. Identify/set goals for regional boards
